What is ICD-10?

ICD-10 IS A SYSTEM FOR MEDICAL DIAGNOSIS AND PROCEDURE CODING FOR CARE MANAGEMENT AND BILLING PURPOSES THAT WENT INTO EFFECT **OCTOBER 1, 2015**. IT IMPACTS EVERY SYSTEM, PROCESS AND TRANSACTION THAT CONTAINS OR USES A DIAGNOSIS OR PROCEDURE CODE.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF ICD-10?

ICD-10-CM and ICD-10-PCS coding provides greater clinical details and have the potential to reveal more about the quality of care, so that data can be used in a more meaningful way to better track the outcomes of care.

WHY DO I NEED ICD-10 CODING TRAINING?

ICD-10 FAST FACTS

- ICD-10 applies to all HIPAA-covered entities
- ICD-10-CM is for diagnosis coding
- ICD-10-PCS is for inpatient procedure coding
- ICD-10-CM/PCS contains more than 141,000 codes
- Provider claims not submitted using ICD-10 codes will be rejected
- Payments to providers depends on the ICD-10 code confirming the Medical Necessity of the visit
