Purpose

The purpose of the LAN is to assist Florida's pediatric and family medicine practices with adopting the PCMH model of care.

Requirements

The requirements for each LAN participant are:

- **1. Enroll your organization in the program**
- 2. Attend and actively participate in all seven LAN Webinar Sessions
- 3. Designate a LAN project lead for your organization
- 4. Participate in all Pre and Post Session Surveys
- 5. Participate in dedicated bi-weekly office hours as needed
- 6. Implement a minimum of three PCMH standards
